Second Neighborhood In Winnebago County Urged To Reduce Exposure To PFAS.

WINNEBAGO COUNTY – The Winnebago County Health Department in coordination with the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency have identified multiple wells with PFAS levels above guidance level in the **Wright Kiles Blackhawk Subdivision in Rockton Township**.

Residents that have PFAS levels above guidance level are being directly notified by IDPH via a letter to the property owner. No source of contamination has been identified. Those that live in this impacted neighborhood (see attached map) and use a private well that have not tested for PFAS should consider testing for PFAS and take steps to remove PFAS from drinking water.

What Are PFAS

PFAS or per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances are a series of man-made chemicals that may impact your health. PFAS are found in a variety of consumer products and water. Reducing exposure to PFAS will lower your risk for health problems.

While all residents should reduce exposure to PFAS, those at greater risk should not drink water that contains PFAS, including:

- Infants and young children whose brains and bodies are developing rapidly
- Pregnant or breastfeeding women, or those planning pregnancy

Reduce Exposure to PFAS from Water Supply

- 1. Use City Water
- 2. Get a Carbon Water Filter or Home Water Treatment System
- 3. Test for Water for PFAS if you use a well that is not on City Water


