O3: By 2023, decrease the rate of suicide in Winnebago County by 10%

Purpose: Review of Suicides Rates in Winnebago County from 2016 to 2021

SUMMARY


From 2016 to 2021, Winnebago County recorded 238 suicides, with 34 (14.3%) occurring among individuals aged 15-24 years and 5 (2.1%) among those under 15 years. Notably, the age group 15-24 years witnessed a concerning increase in suicides from 2019, with the highest rates for 2020 (17.4 deaths per 100,000) and 2021 (28.6 deaths per 100,000). In 2020 a significant decrease in suicides was noticed for Winnebago County population 25 years and above.

Methods:

Rate per 100,000 was calculated by dividing the number of suicides per age group by the total population of the age group in Winnebago county, which was then multiplied by 100,000.
